Post Bellum

Post Bellum is a non-profit organization which has been recording testimonies of 20th century witnesses for over eleven years. The interviewees include war veterans, former concentration camp prisoners, political prisoners, dissidents, and also communists and former Secret Police agents, as well as "ordinary" people who happened to be witnesses of significant events. The collection is accessible on www.memoryofnations.eu and currently contains memories of more than 2,500 witnesses.

We strive to share their memories in various ways. We cooperate with the radio documentary series "Stories of the 20th Century", we hold the Memory of Nation Awards Ceremony, we organize talks with students, publish books, run an interactive education portal for history teachers www.myjsmetonevzdali.cz and we prepare exhibitions just like this one.
